



# 2024 Sidewalk Program

May 14, 2024

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre will soon be starting a sidewalk expansion and construction project in your area. This letter provides details about the project with important information on how construction may impact you. This work will provide additional pedestrian connections completing missing sidewalk links. The 2024 sidewalk program was endorsed by Council on April 17, 2024.

## Project Details:

- Location:** Kilworth
- Schedule:** Tentative start date – June 3, 2024  
Estimated completion – June 17, 2024
- Scope:** Expansion of the existing concrete sidewalks in Kilworth may include removal of existing sub-standard sidewalk, removal of driveways, sod and trees (if required) and will include the installation of new sidewalks and restoration of impacted driveways and boulevards.
- Contractor:** Municipality of Middlesex Centre & concrete sidewalk contractor

## How will Construction Impact You?

**Street Access and Parking:** Streets and sidewalks will have restrictions during construction only allowing local traffic to access their properties. Staff and the contractor will work with impacted properties as it relates to driveway impacts and access to the property.

**Vibration – Protect Valuables:** Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

**Mail Services:** Canada Post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted.

**Garbage and Recycling Collection:** If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction, the Municipality and contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling.

**Manicured Lawns and Boulevards:** The municipality will restore all damaged manicured lawns & boulevards resulting from the construction project. A mixture of seed and water will be applied by the Municipality to such affected locations. We encourage you to assist in the watering process.

**Sprinklers, Flower Beds, Invisible Fences and Private Infrastructure:** Residents are encouraged to remove any private infrastructure and items that may be inadvertently located in the boulevard. The municipality will not be responsible for or repair any private infrastructure damaged or removed as a result of this work.
