



Project Notice: Oxford Street West and Gideon Drive/Kains Road Roundabout

Date: January 31, 2024

To: Business owner, resident and/or property owner

The City of London will soon be starting construction on a roundabout at the Oxford Street West and Gideon Drive intersection. The project will add several improvements including new cycle tracks and sidewalk, pedestrian crossings, landscaping and streetlighting, while replacing and extending underground infrastructure. This letter provides some details and important information about the project, what to expect and how to get involved.

Public Update Meeting:

On Thursday, February 15, 2024, at 12 p.m. the City of London is hosting a virtual Public Update Meeting to provide an update on the project and information about what to expect during construction. The meeting will be recorded and posted on the City of London's Get Involved website, at getinvolved.london.ca/oxfordgideon.

- Participate in a question-and-answer period with the project team



Project Location:

The map below identifies the approximate limits of the construction project area. Work is planned at the Oxford Street West and Gideon Drive intersection, extending east towards Westdel Bourne. The approximate limits are identified in the map below:



Work Details:

- Road removals / traffic diversion for construction purposes
- Sanitary sewer extension
- New storm sewer installation
- Localized tree removals
- Utilities relocation
- Cycle track and sidewalk installation
- Bike racks, benches and rest area in the north-west corner of roundabout
- New asphalt road surface, pavement markings and signage
- New street lighting installation
- Landscaping improvements
- Grading and drainage work

Proposed Timeline:

- Virtual public update meeting: February 15, 2024
- Construction starts: Spring 2024
- Construction ends: End of 2024, with some minor cleanup / asphalt work in Spring 2025
