APPLICATION A-13-2025

We, the undersigned members of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre Committee of Adjustment, do hereby certify that the following is a decision reached by us at a hearing at the Municipality of Middlesex Centre – Municipal Office, Ilderton, Ontario, on Wednesday, July 16, 2025. The said decision was reached on Minor Variance A-13-2025, filed by Jason Baylor and Corinn Ponton, for relief from the Comprehensive Zoning By-law in order to establish a minimum interior side yard setback of 0.66 metres (2.1 feet) for an accessory structure, and an eave encroachment of not more than 0.3 metres (1 foot) against the interior and rear yard setbacks, for a property legally described as Lot 35, Plan M431, in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre, County of Middlesex.
