

2026 Water, Wastewater & Stormwater Rates



In November 2025, Council approved 2026 rates to fund water, wastewater, and stormwater operations and infrastructure renewal. By law, all costs associated with operating municipal water systems must come from users.

In 2026, water rates will increase by 4.5%, wastewater by 5%, and stormwater by 9%. For an average household with all three services, this amounts to an increase of \$6.15 per month before any variable rate charges. For those with stormwater services only, this amounts to an increase of \$1.53 per month.

How much will I pay per month in 2026?

Fixed Monthly Charge — All customers pay a fixed monthly charge depending on the services they receive.

Variable Monthly Charge — Customers that use more than 8 m³ pay an additional charge for each cubic metre.

Infrastructure Lifecycle Reserve Fund — This charge, based on meter size,† helps to pay for repairs and upgrades to the water and wastewater system.

Stormwater Charge* — This charge, applicable to all properties in the settlement areas, helps to pay for repairs and upgrades to the stormwater management system.	\$18.58	\$18.58	\$18.58

Monthly charges for other water meter sizes: 3/4" is \$29.07, 1" is \$48.45, 1.5" is \$96.89, 2" is \$155.03, and 4" is \$581.34.

[†]Monthly charges for other wastewater meter sizes: 3/4" is \$31.31, 1" is \$52.19, 1.5" is \$104.33, 2" is \$166.95, and 4" is \$626.01.

^{*}Industrial, commercial, institutional and multi-residential customers pay an additional monthly fee of \$52.67/ha for properties larger than 0.4 ha.

^{**}Fees apply to developed lots that front but are not connected to the water and wastewater system. Please contact the office for details.
