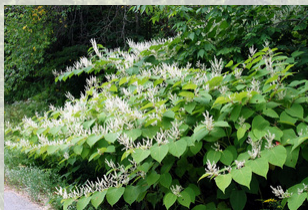


INVASIVE SPECIES MANAGEMENT
